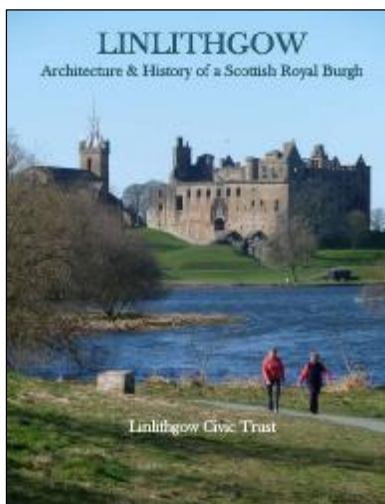


LINLITHGOW CIVIC TRUST

Your Opportunity to Subscribe to 'Linlithgow - Architecture and History of a Scottish Royal Burgh'



Linlithgow Civic Trust is preparing a generously illustrated 64-page book, based on the Architectural and Historical Guide first published by the Trust in 1974, but revised and greatly expanded. The book will contain around 170 photographs, plans and other illustrations, mostly in colour and never previously published, giving a comprehensive account of the architecture and history of Linlithgow. It will be produced to a highly professional standard, with full annotations to each photograph, an original historical overview, and an index.

This should be of interest both to residents of Linlithgow and to visitors who may be inspired to go beyond the palace and church to find the true character of the royal burgh.

In view of the fact that the Civic Trust's funds are limited, and it is unlikely that sufficient large-scale subsidy to meet the full cost of printing the new book will be received prior to the availability of sales income, it is intended to bridge the gap by inviting advance orders with payment.

Civic Trust members and all interested in the town of Linlithgow are therefore invited to **subscribe** to, or **sponsor**, the publication. In return for the advance payment, all subscribers and sponsors will be listed prominently within the new book, and receive a copy/copies as outlined below. Publication is scheduled for October 2010. There are three categories of support which can be given to the venture:

1. As a **subscriber**, at a cost of **£12** per copy (expected to be the eventual retail price); or
2. As a **private sponsor**, at a cost of **£55** for which five copies will be supplied; or
3. As a **corporate sponsor**, at a cost of **£200** for which up to 20 copies will be supplied.
